As my friend and me were attending a Cubs-Brewers game in Milwaukee recently, we met a young couple and struck up a conversation with them. I began talking to the woman about various issues, and at one point she said (actually she emphasized a couple of times) that "Everything happens for a reason." It was almost as if the voice of God was right there in my midst. I agreed with her statement, and it caused me to ponder what she said over the last couple of weeks. In other words, God's providence is working in our lives.

I know that as we look back on our lives, we can definitely see God's hand guiding us and certainly protecting us. I have personally had moments of 'I've been here before' on several occasions, and I think many of us have had similar experiences throughout our lives. It was God's way of telling us that we were exactly where we were supposed to be at that particular time, and also God's message of peace and consolation to us; that He is with us in the good times and the bad times, and to trust in Him as we moved forward in faith.

I was ordained a Catholic priest for the Diocese of Helena on June 6, 2003 at the Cathedral of St. Helena. Robert Morlino was the Bishop of Helena at that time, and he presided at the ordination for Fr. Jeff Benusa and myself. The Bishop's homily that night focused on God's providence; that we were meant to be ordained on that beautiful spring evening, and that our experiences of our lives to that point would benefit us in our priesthood. Fourteen years later, I know that my 'life experiences' have helped me help others in guiding them in their relationship with the Lord, and I know that God's providence continues to work in my life. One event that shines out in my life was ten years ago as I was visiting the Holy Land; just six weeks after the death of my Mother. I had a 'profound' spiritual experience at the Sea of Galilee where I felt the presence of God in a powerful way. I was wrestling with grief at the loss of my Mother, and the trip in many respects was 'a fog,' but that moment made me know that God was with me and would help me through those difficult days, and to trust in Him! May we ALWAYS remember that God's providence has guided us to where we are today, and to trust in Him as we move forward in faith. God bless all of you! Fr. Tim Moriarty
