In the gospel of Matthew 16: 13-20, the Lord asks the disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is? They respond, "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." Then the Lord asks the disciples then and all of us 2,000 years later, "But who do you say that I am?" And Simon Peter responds, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

And after our individual journeys in this world are over, and we meet the Lord face to face, may we be filled with the grace and peace of our Creator as we say to Him with courage and love, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."
